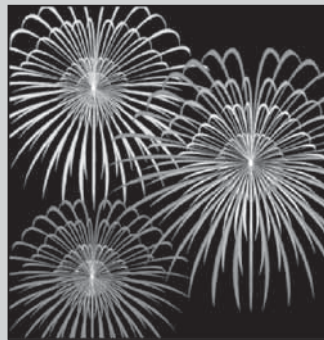

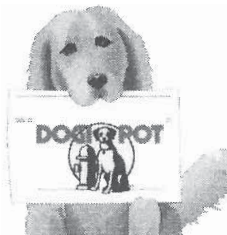
Tennis Court Rules

Tennis Courts may be reserved up to 72 hours in advance.
Tennis Courts #1 through #7 may be reserved on the even hour for a maximum of two hours.

Dog-i-Pot Stations

Remember to use the Dog-i-Pot Stations throughout the year.

When leaving to go outside with your pet, stop by a DOGIPOT and tear off a litter bag when your animal goes "poo poo" so you can pick it up and dispose it in the DOGIPOT Pet Station/Container.



Pool Storm Procedures

1. In the event that a storm arises in the immediate area, lifeguards are urged to keep a constant watch for signs of tornadoes hail or lightening and will close the pool for 30 minutes at a time as needed.
2. Should an electrical storm threaten, the pool will be immediately cleared and an announcement will be made of the closing.
3. If an electrical or hail storm causes the pool to be emptied, residents are not forced to leave the pool area, just to get out of the water until it is safe to return.

Pool Tornado Procedure

1. During a tornado watch the weather will be monitored for safety and may close as needed.
2. During a tornado warning the pool will be cleared and residents are encouraged to go home.

Fishing Rules

Fishing is permitted in the lake areas of: Britany Village, Shenandoah Circle and Lake Crystal.

FISHING RULES

1. Arlington Park residents only (ID required).
2. Fishing equipment must be picked up when leaving the area.
3. No motor boats of any kind are allowed.
4. No harpoons are permitted.
5. No Bow and arrows are permitted.
6. Children under age 10 should be supervised.

Recreational Camp Fires

There is a city ordinance that shall be followed whether you are installing a campfire/fire pit, an enclosed bowl type or fireplace type enclosure for a recreational fire, please see the ordinance stated below. With any of these products, please remember to follow all the manufacturers' specifications, directions and any and all guidelines recommended by the manufacturer. Please take all fire safety precautions when cooking or having a recreational campfire.

The following is the city ordinance relating to open burning and recreational camp fires.

The code states this:

A barbecue pit or grill is a stationary or portable device, with either electric, gas or charcoal fuel, which is used for the preparation of food and is allowed by code, but not within or on balconies of any apartment complex.

A fireplace (like an in-home style whether built or store bought)

which is meant to be a part of your deck or patio is not regulated but there are some safety issues to think about which are the same as the rules for a fire pit. A fire pit or campfire which is meant for recreation, scouting events or family cookouts shall be subject to the following conditions listed:

A garden hose connected to a water supply, buckets, shovel, fire extinguisher or other approved fire extinguishing shall be readily available at the burn site.

Only wood products shall be burned-no leaves, paper or trash.

A fire shall be attended by a responsible party at all times until completely extinguished.

A fire shall be located at least 25 feet away from any structure, fence or right of way.

A fire shall not exceed an area 3 feet wide by 2 feet high.

If the open burning creates a smoke nuisance, or a hazardous condition exists, the open burning shall be immediately extinguished.

Ricky's Kemery offers summer plant tips

FORT WAYNE, Ind. (WANE)- We are reaching for the sunscreen, water and shades, but this is also a time to remember our houseplants in the heat. Houseplants and outdoor gardens alike can suffer from the scorching sun and drought.

Former Allen County Extension Educator Ricky Kemery has created an online newsletter to help you with your plants.

Ricky says to keep plants from getting burnt use drip irrigation or soaker hoses when possible. Try to mulch bare garden areas keeping the mulch away from the base of the plant.

Ricky likes newspaper first, then bark mulch. His raised bed flowers and large container vegetables need watering about every two to three days when there is no rain. Smaller containers need watering every day.

For keeping your lawn hydrated, Ricky says there needs to be about a half inch of water per week to stay alive in urban areas. He says to use an empty tuna can or pie tin to measure the water. However, if we receive more than a half inch of rain in a week,

there's no need to water.

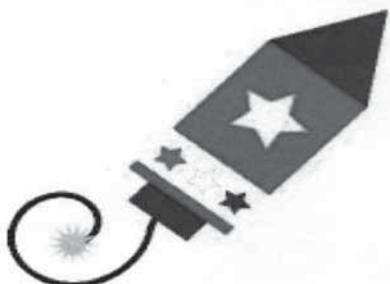
