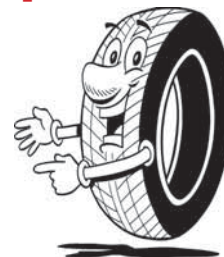

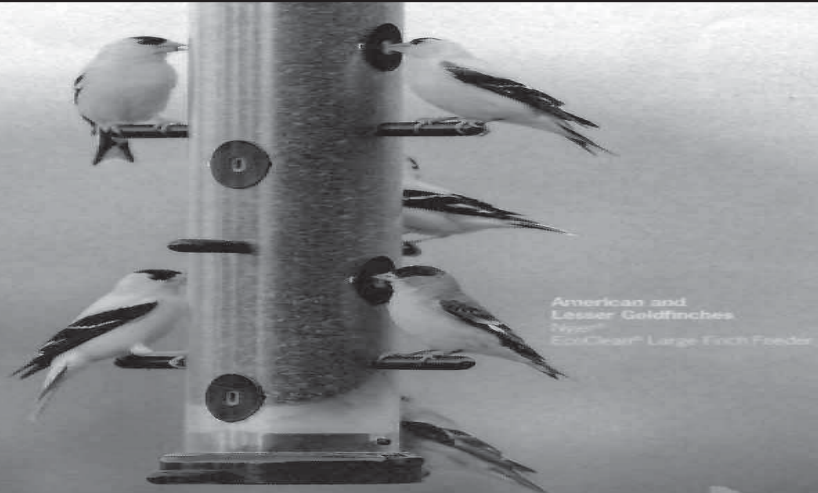

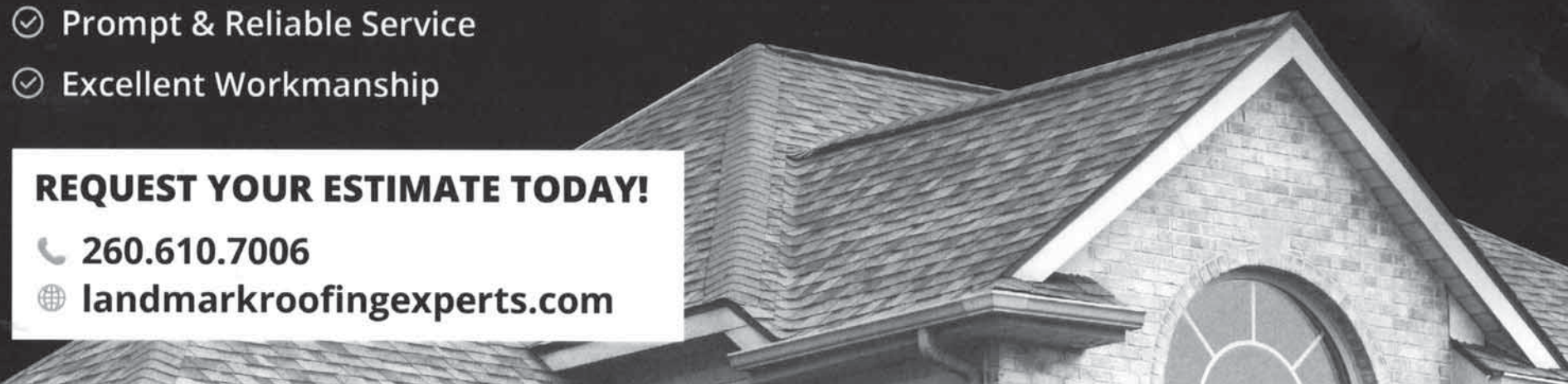

In attendance: Executive Director Millie McDonald, President Lynda Gevers, Vice President Bruce Westendorf, Treasurer Harlan Altena, Secretary Kyle Lehman (Proxy Lynda), Ryan Delagrang, Sarah Garman, Kevin Snowball, Daniel Paine, Alayna Hackert. Guests: Pat Sauers, Administrative Assistant.

The meeting was called to order by Lynda Gevers, President at 6 p.m.

Discussed results from Ballroom Dance Survey, shows 34 in favor of (interested), 22 not interested. Sarah will send results to dance instructor, cc' in Executive Director. Survey will be terminated.

Discussed News and Views. Followed up from discussion ensued in July meeting and recent survey. Results indicated 85% of responders in favor of 15% against as it regards to going digital only. Motion was made to move forward with this plan beginning with the January issue, with a distribution of flyers and blast emails to residents regarding such. This was seconded and passed.

During discussion of News and Views, the issue of updating

the Arlington Park website was addressed. Options and pricing are being explored.

Executive Director discussed pool expenditures and past closures related to repairs.

Discussed Golf Concrete repair and expansion. Four bids were received and examined. Motion made to contract with D&M Construction, they are licensed and bonded. It was seconded and passed.

Discussion of Bids for Leveling of Concrete. After thorough discussion. Motion made to contract with Next Level Services. Seconded. One Board member abstained due to a conflict of interest. One vote no. Six yes. Motion passed.

Annual Tour conducted by all Board members present to access current assets, needs and amenities within Arlington, which will aid in the preparation of the 2025 Long-Term Budget.

Motion to adjourn, seconded and passed at 8:40 p.m. Next scheduled meeting will be Sept. 9, 2024 at 6 p.m.

Pool Storm Procedures

1. In the event that a storm arises in the immediate area, lifeguards are urged to keep a constant watch for signs of tornadoes hail or lightning and will close the pool for 30 minutes at a time as needed.

2. Should an electrical storm threaten, the pool will be immediately cleared and an announcement will be made of the closing.

3. If an electrical or hail storm causes the pool to be emptied, residents are not forced to leave the pool area, just to get out of the water until it is safe to return.

Pool Tornado Procedure

1. During a tornado watch the weather will be monitored for safety and may close as needed.

2. During a tornado warning the pool will be cleared and residents are encouraged to go home.

Fishing

Fishing is permitted in the lake areas of Brittany Village, Shenandoah Circle and Lake Crystal. Because we are privately owned a fishing license is not required.

The current harvesting rule is: No size limit on Bluegill, but Bass must be a minimum of 14 inches long to keep or they must be returned to the lake.
